You will identify available funding opportunities, build a pipeline of grants, trusts, and contracts, and create high-quality submissions to secure income aligned with Inspire's plans and goals.

A strong bid writer or someone with transferable skills, you'll be self-motivated, action-oriented, and have excellent written and verbal communication and organisational skills. You'll enjoy taking funding applications from start to finish and building strong relationships to deliver impact.

With a proven track record in bid writing and project development, you'll understand how to meet or exceed funder expectations for continued support. An organised, strategic thinker, you'll quickly grasp how Youth Zone's operate and create strategies to secure funding that aligns with delivery goals. You'll use research and writing skills to craft compelling grant applications that ensure success.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Identify a range of grant making organisations with the potential of funding activity along with other, more complex contract funders to develop a strong and mixed pool of organisations.
- Contribute to the development of a strong pipeline of grant and contract organisations, fully researched and aligned to areas of delivery for potential support.
- Achieve a small but defined set of KPIs including activity targets relating to developing a pipeline, applying to organisations and securing outcomes.
- Attend and contribute to relevant network meetings and work collaboratively with OnSide colleagues with regard to the development of network-wide bids which may benefit Inspire as well as the implementation of successful bids.

- Work closely with the Grants and Contracts Manager, and the wider Team, to ensure that funding secured is translated to impact, with any funding requirements clearly articulated and managed.
- Work with the wider team to assist with stewardship and collation of impact for funders.
- Monitor and report on progress against funding requirements, ensuring project is on track and demonstrating expected impact and outcomes.
- Ensure all records are kept up to date on our CRM database.
- Ensure accurate and timely acknowledgement, recording and banking of any grants received, or income secured.

- Proven experience and track record of bid or tender writing and securing income at various levels, or experience in a similar/related field.
- Good organisational skills, able to prioritise effectively and arrange workload around multiple tasks
- Ability to read and understand complex funding requirements and translate these to clear objectives to ensure delivery
