## 224 YOUTH ZONE

Opening in Spring 2026, 224 Youth Zone, Bristol will become the new home and evolution of Youth Moves. Empowering Young People in South Bristol at Youth Moves, we create spaces where young people feel safe, supported, and empowered to be themselves. Our mission is to help them build confidence, find happiness, and have fun while ensuring their voices are heard. Our youth clubs provide welcoming, purpose-built spaces in the heart of South Bristol. Here, young people can connect, take part in diverse activities, and engage in projects that benefit their communities. Beyond our youth clubs, we offer targeted youth work and one-to-one mentoring tailored to individual needs. We also collaborate closely with schools to provide additional support and actively reach out to engage young people in their neighbourhoods.

## THE FUTURE: 224 YOUTH ZONE

In 2026, in partnership with OnSide and Bristol City Council, Youth Moves will open 224 Youth Zone, a dynamic, state-of-the-art hub designed to inspire and uplift young people. This will become the new home of our award-winning charity. 224 Youth Zone isn't just a youth centre; it's a space for young people aged 8 to 19 (and up to 25 for those with additional needs) to explore their passions and unlock their potential. With over 20 different activities, including football, boxing, climbing, creative arts, music, drama, and employability training, there's something for everyone. Our team of skilled and dedicated youth workers will be at the heart of the Youth Zone, offering guidance, encouragement, and support. Whether through informal chats or structured activities, they will help young people build confidence and work towards their dreams. As part of OnSide's national Youth Zone network, 224 Youth Zone will bring together the local community, authorities, and businesses to create lasting opportunities for young people. We believe that investing in the next generation is an investment in a brighter future for all. For just 50p per visit, members will have access to: Indoor climbing wall, 3G kick pitch, fully equipped gym, dance and drama studio, music room, arts and crafts room, skate park, training kitchen, martial arts gym, enterprise suite, health, and wellbeing room, and much more. We'll also have a café serving hot meals for just £1! This is for every session open.

## JOB TITLE:

Outdoor & Wellbeing Sessional Youth Worker

This role involves regular evening & weekend shifts

## THE ROLE

At 224 Youth Zone, we believe that every young person deserves a safe, inspiring place to grow and thrive. As an Outdoor & Wellbeing Sessional Youth Worker, you'll help deliver a fun, inclusive and high-quality programme of activities for young people aged 8 to 19 (up to 25 years of age with additional needs). You will engage and support members across our Juniors (8-12) and Seniors (13-19) sessions, encouraging participation in a range of activities including outdoor activities and other activities focussed on wellness.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

### Key Responsibilities:

- Deliver wellbeing activities (e.g. confidence building, stress management, mindfulness, creative or physical wellbeing sessions)
- Support emotional literacy and healthy coping strategies
- Encourage positive routines, self-care and resilience
- Promote balance between mental, physical and social wellbeing



- Encourage young people to express feelings, needs and choices
- Support young people to build confidence and self-advocacy
- Involve young people in shaping wellbeing activities and spaces
- Be part of delivering engaging, inclusive, and high-quality sessions
- Build positive, professional relationships with children and young people
- Encourage participation, positive behaviour, and enjoyment in all activities
- Motivate and support children and young people to try new activities and take part fully
- Work inclusively, adapting activities to ensure all children and young people can participate and feel welcome
- Act as a positive role model and maintain clear professional boundaries
- Support the mission of 224 Youth Zone by delivering high-quality youth work that supports children and young people's personal, social, and educational development

### **Teamwork, Culture & Engagement:**

- Work collaboratively with staff and volunteers to deliver sessions
- Support and guide volunteers during sessions to help them develop in their roles
- Contribute to a positive, welcoming, and inclusive culture across the Youth Zone
- Bring new ideas, skills, and enthusiasm to the team and programme offer
- Represent 224 Youth Zone positively with colleagues, partners, and visitors
- Support promotional activities, visits, and events at the Youth Zone
- Actively promote the Youth Zone and encourage membership and engagement

### **Safeguarding, Safety & Standards:**

- Follow all safeguarding and child protection policies and procedures, and promptly report any concerns in line with organisational processes
- Promote health and safety, wellbeing, equality, and diversity at all times
- Follow all organisational policies, procedures, and codes of conduct

- Work within the performance framework of the organisation and live the values of 224 Youth Zone and the OnSide Network, contributing to a culture of high performance, continuous improvement and a young person first, team always ethos.
- Represent and promote the Youth Zone positively and effectively in all dealings with internal colleagues and external partners, assist with any promotional activities and visits

that take place at 224.

- Comply with all policies, procedures, and codes of conduct, with particular reference to Safeguarding, Health & Safety, and Equity, Diversity & Inclusion.
- Carry out other reasonable duties assigned by senior leadership.

- Experience of working with children and young people from diverse backgrounds and with a range of needs
- Experience of working as part of a team
- Ability to work on own initiative and as part of a team
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
- Ability to communicate effectively with children and young people, parents/carers, colleagues, and members of the public
- Good organisational skills, including the ability to plan, manage time effectively, and meet deadlines
- Ability to plan and evaluate activities or sessions, including completing basic session plans and evaluations
- Knowledge of safeguarding, health and safety, equality, and diversity best practice
- Reliable and punctual, with good timekeeping
- Flexible and willing to work evenings, weekends, and other unsociable hours when required and willingness to cover events, holidays, and staff absence as needed
- Commitment to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people

We will create and nurture strong, creative partnerships, working together to achieve better results and outcomes for young people.

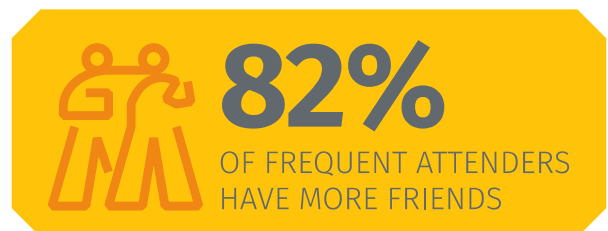
